



Rite Aid Pharmacy has many vaccines available without an appointment. Our Board Certified Pharmacist can vaccinate children as young as 7 years old, without a prescription. Most insurance companies, including Oregon Health Plan, will pay, at no out of pocket cost to the individual.

The CDC, Center for Disease Control, recommends that anyone who cares for or has contact with the vulnerable population; young children and the elderly, should get vaccinated against the flu. It is one of the most effective methods against spreading the deadly virus to their loved ones.

Avoid exclusion with up to date immunizations. At Rite Aid, we strive to help keep our communities healthy and safe. Please come in to any Rite Aid and meet our friendly staff. We are happy to assist you.

Additional Note from Silver Falls School District Nursing Department:

We have called around and due to the recent outbreak of Measles in the Portland/Vancouver area, the Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) vaccine is not available at the Silverton Rite Aid at this time, however doses were available at neighboring (Keizer) Rite Aid Pharmacies. Vaccinations are available usually on a walk-in bases. You may want to call ahead to verify availability- **(503) 873-2460. Rite Aid**
